



WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO...

Colorado Steppin' Out for Kids (CSOK) is a non-profit organization that provides school clothes to hundreds of Denver area children (grades K-8) who live below the poverty level.

WHY SCHOOL CLOTHES?

We believe that having new school clothes contributes immeasurably to a child's self-esteem, confidence and pride, allowing them to learn.

HOW WE DO IT...

Social welfare organizations, community organizations and schools identify kids who need CSOK's help. These are some of the 100,000 school-aged Denver children who are in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program and live at low-income levels.

We buy each child a brand new, appropriately sized wardrobe that includes pants, shirts, shoes, socks, underwear and a new winter coat. We then put each wardrobe in a new plastic tub so the child will have a special place to store the new clothes. The kids get their clothes in time for the first day of school.

100% of all donations go to the children...

CSOK is a 501(c) (3) non-profit corporation. We have no paid staff, and our dedicated founders and Board of Directors cover all annual administrative costs. So when you contribute, your money goes directly to the kids.

OUR MISSION...

is to provide children in need with a basic wardrobe prior to the start of the academic year. This removes one of many tangible roadblocks these children face in getting an education by providing them with increased dignity and confidence in themselves.
